**The Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Regulations 2013 (as amended)  
Notification of grant of approval of an exporter**

We have considered your application for approval as an exporter (AE) under the Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Regulations 2013 (as amended) and hereby grant approval to **S. Sacker (Claydon) Limited** to operate as an AE. Your approval number is **WEE/LU0007ZT/EXP** and covers the specified overseas site listed in the attached annex.

Your approval is subject to the conditions of approval specified in Part 3 of Schedule 11 to the Regulations. A copy of these conditions is attached.

Your approval is valid from 01 January 2018 and ends on 31 December 2018, unless it is otherwise suspended or cancelled. The approval applies only to the named exporter for the specified overseas site.

This approval applies only to the legal entity named in this letter. If this changes then your approval will be deemed to be cancelled and you must make a new application for approval. If you cease to be an exporter your approval will also be deemed to be cancelled.

You must notify us immediately, in writing, of any changes to the details submitted with your application. If you wish to export to any additional overseas sites you must submit an application to extend your approval to cover these sites, including a fee of £110 for each site.

The approval allows you to issue evidence notes for waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE) which you export to this specified overseas site and which is subsequently re-used. You must not issue evidence for WEEE that has already been partially treated. You must not issue evidence for WEEE unless it can be lawfully sent to and received at the intended site in the country of destination.

If you issue evidence notes for greater than 400 tonnes of WEEE you must inform us immediately and you will be liable to pay the balance of the charge, namely £2070, from that date.

This approval does not replace any other environmental authorisation(s) that you may have for the site. You must continue to comply with these and other relevant legislation.

You must ensure that international shipments of WEEE are in accordance with the Waste Shipments Regulations. AEs wishing to be approved for the next compliance period (1 January – 31 December 2019) and to have their approval run continuously, should apply to the Environment Agency using the relevant application forms before 30 September 2018.
